Dr Anne Weaver - Consultant in Emergency Medicine & Prehospital Care, Clinical Director for Trauma at the Royal London Hospital, National Specialty Advisor for Major Trauma & Burns, UK.

Anne is a Consultant in Emergency Medicine & Pre-hospital Care at the Royal London Hospital. She was Lead Clinician for London's Air Ambulance from 2007-14. In May 2016, she was appointed as Clinical Director for Trauma at the Royal London.

Her special interests include pre-hospital care, trauma, transfusion, major incidents and clinical governance. Anne led on the development and implementation of the Code Red pre-alert system in 2008, which was adopted across London in 2010. She led the introduction of "blood on board" in 2012, when London's Air Ambulance became the first UK service to routinely carry blood. Since then she has tested the feasibility of a combined red cells and plasma product in the pre-hospital setting and is a Principle Investigator for the SWiFT trial, investigating the use of pre-hospital whole blood.
